### Meet Information

**Entry Fee:** \$250 per gender, or \$500 for both men's and women's team. Make checks payable to: MU Track & Field. Coaches should pay their entry fees upon arrival in the tent by the finish line

**Athletic Training:** The training room will be available for heat and ice only. Trainers will be on hand to assist with injuries and emergencies during the competition. Taping can be done by our trainers but your athletes will need to supply the taping materials.

**Facility:** The track is a Benyon BSS 300. LJ/TJ/HJ/PV surface is the same as the track. The approach for Javelin will be grass.

**Hammer Throw:** The Hammer & Javelin will be contested on Friday. All other events will be contested on Saturday. The start of the Hammer & Javelin will be 1PM.

**Meet Conduct:** NCAA Rules

**Implement:** Weigh in 45 minutes prior to the event.

**Timing:** Entries will be through directathletics. Entries are due by Wednesday (3/25) before by 7:00PM

**Scoring:** NCAA Scoring
