



Midwest Elite Meet Powered by NIKE/Second Sole Meet Information

Date: Sat, 6/13/2026 from 2:00PM to approximately 10:00PM

Venue: Baldwin Wallace University George Finnie Stadium
and Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds (Discus Throw & Shot Put only)

Events: 11 Girls & Boys Events Total: 100, 100/110 Hurdles, 400, 800, 1600, 4x4, Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump, Pole Vault and High Jump

Eligibility: Athletes Graduating High School in '26, '27, '28 '29 & '30 are eligible

Meet Goal: To provide athletes an opportunity to compete with other elite athletes in a unique, fast moving, exciting environment under the best conditions possible. To best achieve this goal, the meet will feature:

- Baldwin Wallace University's outstanding track & field venue including the only MONDO X track surface in Ohio
- Elite night sections of running events contested under the lights in a tight 2-hour time frame

Swag: Exclusive NIKE jersey for Elite section qualifiers and alternate NIKE item for open participants

Implements: Athletes bring their own implements. Weigh in will be one hour before the start of each throwing event.

Awards: TBD

Spikes: ¼" Pyramid spikes only. No needle or Christmas tree spikes.

Indoor Facility: No access to Lou Higgins Center/Indoor Track Facility

Admission: There will be a \$10 **CASH ONLY** fee for all spectators (parents, guardians, siblings, friends) over the age of 12

Parking: Parking will be available in the lot connected to George Finnie Stadium or across the street at the Lou Higgins Center. Parking for throws will be available at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds where the event is taking place.

Event Check In: Running Event competitors will pick up your hip numbers at least 30 minutes before the event starts at check-in under George Finnie Stadium's electronic scoreboard. Check in with the clerk at the start line 10 minutes prior to the event starting. Field event athletes check in 30 minutes prior to start of event or before.

Horizontal Jumps and Throws: Competitors will be given 3 attempts and the top 9 will qualify for finals.

Field Event Warm Up: Will be available immediately following the conclusion of the

prior event.

Athletic Training: There will be NO Athletic Trainers on site! All competitors completed a waiver on MileSplit.com (waiver included on last page) upon initial registration for the meet

Concessions: Small amounts of concession snacks will be available via **CASH PURCHASE ONLY** until sold out: water, Gatorade, Coca-Cola, Doritos/Lays chip varieties, Rice Krispies Treats, fruit snacks, etc.

Entry Procedure:

- Entries will open on milesplit.com on March 1st, 2026.
- Be sure to update any performance improvements throughout the season to keep lists accurate.
- Only marks from the 2026 season will be accepted. Running event times must be FAT
- If using a 1500 time to enter the 1600, use the conversion factor of 1.0737. **Example: 1500 = 4:00, 240 seconds x 1.0737 = 257.69 seconds, entry time for 1600 =4:17.69.**
- Entry Deadline: Tuesday, June 9th @ 11:59 PM EST
- Elite Sections, Open Sections and adjusted time schedule will be posted on Wednesday, June 10th
- *Performance Lists* will be available through wingmantiming.com and bwyellowjackets.com
- Entry fee of \$25 is due before this time. Your payment guarantees your spot in the meet. If in multiple events, still pay only \$25 total. THIS IS AN ENTRY FEE, NOT A COMPETITION FEE— There are no refunds for non-accepted entries, scratches or no-show athletes.

Timing: Fully-automatic timing system and LIVE results by wingmantiming.com

Medical Release: Baldwin Wallace University requires that all those participating must have a BW issued medical release form completed **with parent or legal guardian's signature**. Forms must be handed in to BW at Packet Pickup. You will not be allowed to compete if you do not have your parent or guardians signature on the sheet.
